

## Updates Checklist

---

- Commit changes into SVN repository <sup>1</sup>
- Notify person who reported the bug, about the fix <sup>2</sup>
- Update the "Contents.m" file accordingly
  - update version number according to the versioning guidelines <sup>3</sup>
  - update/add/remove function descriptions as necessary
- Update the user manual if necessary
- Update website
  - Update the manual PDF file if it has changed
  - Update the "Version History" page
  - Update the downloadable ZIP file
  - Update the "What is TSlib" page if necessary
- Update TSlib on server running Ruby script
- Send out an email notification via the mailing list

<sup>1</sup> Try to write a meaningful description of the changes made when committing, since this is what Chris will use when updating the version history and notifying the users

<sup>2</sup> If we start using BugZilla, this will happen automatically

<sup>3</sup> Versioning:

X - Major Revision (general version)

Y - Minor Revision (iteration number)

Z - Number of Bug Fixes in this particular release

W - (optional) = b if beta/development version
